

Continuing Enrollment Policy

Students Taking Majority of Coursework Onsite: Parents must provide an excuse for any absence (e.g., illness, family emergency, funeral, wedding, doctor's appointment, etc.). Failure to do so will result in the absence being recorded as "unexcused." An "unexcused absence" is equivalent to "truant." Should a student have ten (10) or more consecutive unexcused absences, he or she shall be dropped from the school's enrollment. Re-entry into the school shall follow the lottery enrollment process.

Secondary Students Taking Majority of Coursework Online and Offsite: Attendance shall be taken daily based upon the timestamps of a student course logins. Attendance shall be reported before noon the following day. Attendance shall be recorded for the previous day, allowing a student to login to their coursework in the evening, if required. Parents must provide an excuse for any absence (e.g., illness, family emergency, funeral, wedding, doctor's appointment, etc.). Failure to do so will result in the absence being recorded as "unexcused." An "unexcused absence" is equivalent to "truant." Should a student have ten (10) or more consecutive unexcused absences, he or she shall be dropped from the school's enrollment. Re-entry into the school shall follow the lottery enrollment process.

Elementary Students Taking Majority of Coursework Online and Offsite: Student activity within the online platform shall be checked daily. Students that fail to log into the platform and make progress in their courseware within a 5-day period shall receive notice of truancy. Students that fail to log into the platform and make progress in their courseware within a 10-day period shall be dropped from the school's enrollment. Re-entry into the school must follow the lottery enrollment process.
