Financial Information:

1. All Registration fees must be paid before classes begin **(Aug 21, 2018)**. A check for all required fees must be made out for the exact amount plus any additional fees that are selected.
2. Students owing money from previous years need to clear balance before registration.
3. Any student or parent check that is returned to AISU from the bank will be assessed a \$15.00 returned check fee.
4. Please save your receipts for the school year.

Fines:

Fines will be assessed to cover the cost of damage or loss of school property such as computers or other electronic devices, books, school property etc. Students must pay all fines, and other financial responsibilities by the end of each trimester, or transcripts will be withheld until the obligation is cleared. A fine for vandalism will be assessed and the cost of repairs/replacement will be assessed to the student. Vandalism in excess of \$200 can result in an expulsion from school. Yearbooks and student diplomas will be withheld from students until all fines are paid.
